## **Pastor Randy's Ramblings:**

Hello Brothers and Sisters of Bethlehem!

I can't believe we are already talking about April! As I write this, the first day of spring has just passed and the sun is shining. It's hard not to start thinking about the abundant new life spring brings: green grass, leaves on the trees, hostas and daffodils pushing up from the soil.

But let's not rush it. There is still part of Lent to be experienced. As I've mentioned before, Lent is a time of darkness, but it's also a time of self-reflection, penitence, and finding ways to draw nearer to God. We still need to walk with Jesus into Jerusalem and face the crowds. The crowds who first praise and cheer him, but later mock him, jeer him, and demand his execution.

In the remaining days of Lent I encourage you to really double-down in your self-examination. In what ways are WE like that jeering crowd who turned their backs and betrayed Jesus? How often do we deny knowing Jesus in order to save face? When do we hear the teachings of Jesus, yet turn and do the opposite? These are difficult questions to grapple with, yet at some level, we all "betray" Jesus in some way. We're often too complacent and are perfectly satisfied letting Jesus take the fall for our sins. But you know what? That's okay. I say it's okay because that's exactly why Jesus went to the cross. For you, and for me, for the redemption of our sins.

## Pastor Randy's Ramblings (continued):



#### Loads of Love:





#### **From Our Church Historian:**



The Bethlehem Sunday School has supported the Leprosy Mission for 60 plus years. On your birthday, you would bring one penny for each year of your age. You would deposit your money into a special piggy bank. The classes would then sing "Happy Birthday" to you. At the end of the year, the money would be

sent to Leprosy Missions to cure a child of Leprosy.

As time went on the amount given was raised to a nickel for each year. In 1999 the amount was raised from a nickel to a dime. In 2007 the amount given was again raised to a quarter per year. The children got excited at the huge amount an "old" teacher would be donating. A 30 year old teacher would be giving \$7.50 to the piggy bank.

In 1999 the Sunday School designated the month of February as Leprosy/Birthday month. The children and teachers would bring their birthday money regardless of when their birthday is. Singing "Happy Birthday" is still done on the child's birthday. Videos and stories were shared with the children to educate them on the disease of Leprosy. From Biblical times we hear the story of Jesus healing the 10 lepers.

Since 2017 the Sunday School's mission project has been supplemented by the Jingle Change collection. Currently it takes \$350 to cure one child. No matter what the amount of the collection, the Sunday School donated enough money to cure one child, using other fund raising monies.
